

Adding Images in Dynamic Documentation

Images tagged from the Media Gallery component within Workflow can be added into a Dynamic Documentation Note. The Media Gallery component is integrated with Cerner mobile app *Camera Capture* and allows clinicians to view and add pictures uploaded from the app to a patients' chart into the note.

Tagging in Media Gallery

1. Click the **Media Gallery** component.

Group by Date view will show the latest image at the top.

Change View by clicking Menu and changing to *Group by Content Type* or *Group by Date*.

Group by Content Type will show folders.

Click **View** to see media in a larger view.

Make the thumbnail images bigger or smaller by dragging the blue dial.

Tagging Images


3. Click **Tag**.

Single or multiple images may be tagged to include in note.


2. Click the box(s) under the image to select media.

Add Images to Dynamic Document

Images must be tagged **prior** to creating the note. If the note has been created, the image will not populate in the note. If the note has been started without tagging the images, copy the note content, tag the image and create a new note. The existing note will need to be canceled if not signed or in-errored if it has been signed.
