

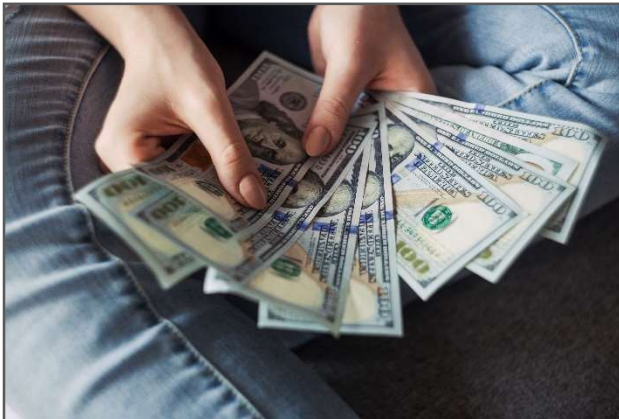
5 Considerations for Measuring Success of A Change Project

SCHEDULE

Success may be measured by whether or not you kept the original timeline. This is easier if you continually evaluate your progress as you work through the project.

COST

This is an important consideration for executives. Compare your actual spent to what you had budgeted. Ensure that you explain any variances to your budget.

PERFORMANCE TO BUSINESS CASE

Go back to your business case and review the project scope. Compare what was agreed upon versus what was actually accomplished.

QUALITY

The end of the project is a good time for a quality review. Check the quality of your project and change management practices. Look at how successful you were at the project deliverables.



5

STAKEHOLDER SATISFACTION

Check in with your stakeholders to find out how they are currently feeling about the project and what could be done differently.
