
Quick Reference Guide



Safety Instructions

- Read the instruction manual for the lift before use.
- Maximum Load 600 lbs
- Always ensure that the appropriate slings are used. Carefully confirm weight and size selection before lifting.
- Visually inspect sling prior to every lift.
- This Quick Reference Guide is not a substitute for the owner's manual. Carefully read the entire owner's manual before operating lift.

Hand Controller / Control Box



5 Spreader Bar Positioning Supine Lifting/Rolling



Spreader bar placement is perpendicular to the patient's shoulders

2 Emergency Stop



Push red emergency stop button located on base of lift

Spreader Bar Positioning Seated Lifting




Parallel to the patient's shoulders

4 Charging of Batteries


- Charge the lift regularly after use.
- The lift does not function during charging.
- Lift will not overcharge.

6 Emergency Lowering



Pulling upward on the red emergency lowering control initiates the lowering process

7 Locking the Wheels



Do not lock the wheels when lifting or lowering patients

8 Safety Clips

Ensure the safety clip on the spreader bar is in position after sling has been applied.



Ergonomics

- Never lift manually let the lift do the lifting.
- Work calmly and methodically
- Don't strain your back! Work in a walking stance with your back straight.
- Use the bed's raising and lowering functions.
- Reduce the lever effect. Work close to the patient and the lift.

Simple Troubleshooting

Check to ensure that:

- Emergency stop is not pressed in.
- The battery is charged.
- The hand control is connected properly.

Cleaning

When necessary, clean the lift with a moist cloth, using common hard surface cleaners or disinfectants.

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
