

Fall 2019 Cohort Nurse Residency

Completion of Nurse Residency Seminars, Evidence Based Practice project, RN licensure for a year, attendance of two unit based shared leadership meetings, and completions of unit provided training are required for your advancement from Staff Nurse I to II. Monthly seminars run four hours and allow time to work on an approved EBP Project and reflection on your first year as a professional nurse. Experienced facilitators will guide Tiger Tale groups during the first hour of Seminars.
