









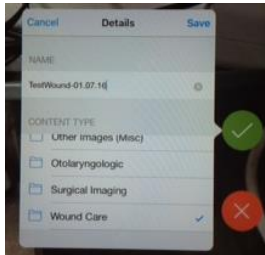




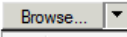




PowerChart Touch Camera Capture

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| <p>Log in</p>  | <p>Follow these instructions:</p> <p>Touch the Camera Capture Button on your device Log into app with PowerChart username & password</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Select patient ... one of the following ways <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Outpatient schedule which displays  Inpatient rounding list by tapping the right side of this icon  Search for patient by tapping  Patient or  |
| <p>Capture Image</p> | <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Capture image ... tap the shutter button  Discard image ... tap reject  To save image to patient's chart... tap accept  Update file name & content type appears when image is accepted. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Naming the file image with discription of image is helpful for others when in patient's chart. Content Type determines which folder store image in MultiMedia Manager in PowerChart Save file to patient's chart ... tap  (Save) <p>Return to patient list when all need patient images are captured ... tap </p>  |
| <p>Pull image into PowerNote</p>  link  image | <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Log into patient's chart in PowerChart on Workstation Document Viewing ... *2G note (PowerNote) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> For thumbnail image in note <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Start your note OR select an existing note and click Modify (choose Correct Note for signed notes) Click Insert Image icon  Select MultiMedia Manager & click OK Locate image, click to select, click Include Image immediately displays in note For image hyperlink attachment in note <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Start your note OR select an existing note and click Modify (choose Correct Note for signed notes) Click Attachment icon  Select MultiMedia Manager from Browse drop down  Locate image, click to select, click Include Attachment will not appear until note is signed <p>Note: not available for Dynamic Documentation at this time.</p> |
| <p>Things to know</p>  | <ol style="list-style-type: none"> You cannot view the patient's chart from this app If you don't rename your image, it will default to the date & time the image was taken Attachments icon  is available everywhere, so you can always insert a link. |
