

Specimen Collection Process - PowerChart

1) Gather the collection supplies, including the **preprinted Zebra Labels**

2) At the Bedside; **Open PowerChart**

3) Select the patient in PowerChart; (PAL, Care Compass or open chart)

4) Click the **Specimen Collection icon** on the tool bar  Specimen Collection

5) **Scan the Patient's ID wristband**

6) **Scan the bar code label** to match label to the order for this patient;

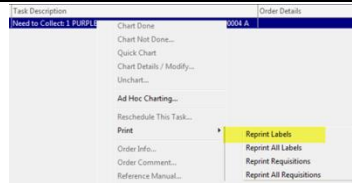

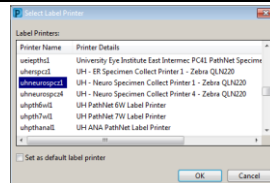
Reprinting Specimen Labels Task List (must have accession #)

- 3) Then select **Reprint Labels**



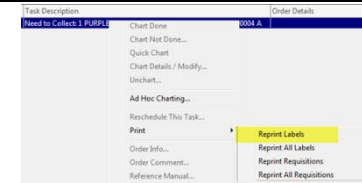
- 4) Verify the order listed is the label needed

- 7) Click **OK** to reprint label



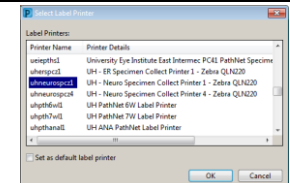
Reprinting Specimen Labels Task List (must have accession #)

- 3) Then select **Reprint Labels**



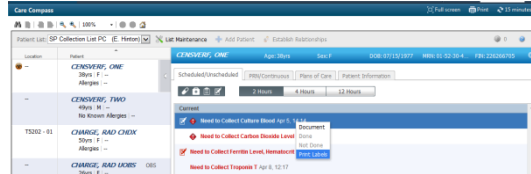

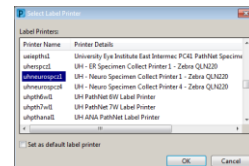
Reprinting Specimen Labels (PowerChart Only)

- 2) Select **Print Labels**



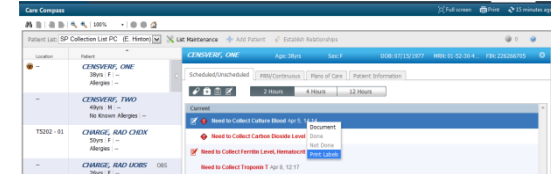
- 3) Verify the order listed is the label needed

- 6) Click **OK** to reprint label



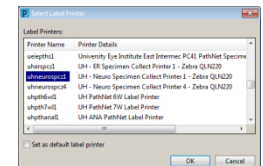
Reprinting Specimen Labels (PowerChart Only)

From Care Compass:

- 1) **Right-Click** on the task
- 2) Select **Print Labels**

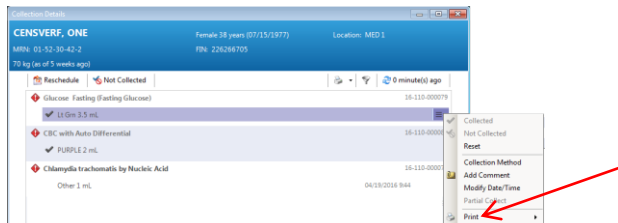


- 3) Verify the order listed is the label needed
